**AMHERST PUBLIC LIBRARY
LIBRARY TERRACE POLICY AND PROCEDURE**

The Amherst Public Library provides an outdoor terrace on the second floor, which may be used seasonally for leisure and reading activities as weather permits, and may occasionally be used for Library events and programs.

The Library terrace is limited to patrons 18 years of age and older, unless accompanied by a responsible adult aged 21 or older. Minors under 18 without adult supervision will be asked to locate elsewhere in the Library.

Access to the terrace will be available to the public on a first-come, first-serve basis and may not be reserved by groups other than the Library and the Friends of the Library.

Weather permitting, the terrace will be open April – October and will be closed November – March. Access to the terrace may be further limited at the Library’s discretion or for Library programs and events.

Food and drink are permitted on the terrace. Those using the terrace are responsible for cleaning any spills and crumbs, and for discarding garbage in the provided trash cans.
